#### **ADVOCACY**

- BGCT: Christian Life Commission
  - Educates churches about ethical issues
  - Advocates for justice in Texas & federal governments

#### 2015-2016 Public Policy Priorities:

- Alcohol and Addiction
- Criminal Justice
- Promote quality public **Education** for all Texas children
- Energy and Environment
- Oppose Gambling Expansion
- Health Care
- Human Trafficking and Immigration
- Hunger and Nutrition
- End Predatory Lending
- Protect Religious Liberty for all people
- SBTC: No public advocacy agency

#### CHAPLAINCY

- BGCT: Sponsors & endorses over 700 chaplains now serving in diverse places
- SBTC: Neither sponsors nor endorses any chaplains

#### CHURCH STARTING

- BGCT: Sept. 2012 to April 2013 (7 months), helped to start 134 new churches
- SBTC: Sept. 2012 to Sept. 2013 (12 months), "involved in the start of at least forty new congregations" (2013 SBTC Book of Reports)

#### **EDUCATION**

- BGCT: Partners in providing Christian-based education to over 27,000 students in 10 institutions, plus two seminaries
- **SBTC:** Supports education to approx. **900** students in two institutions

### FREEDOM (LOCAL CHURCH AUTONOMY)

- BGCT: Each church gives as God leads, either to Southern Baptist Convention (SBC), Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, or both
- **SBTC:** Each church **required** to give to Southern Baptist Convention alone
- BGCT: Each church allocates its Cooperative Program gifts between Texas and national
- SBTC: Each church required to give a specified percentage to national SBC.

#### **HEALTH CARE**

- BGCT: Six hospital systems that, in 2012, provided care to over 250,000 patients and treated over 3.4 million outpatients
- SBTC: Supports no hospitals

#### **POVERTY & HUNGER INITIATIVES**

- BGCT: In 2013, raised \$953,000 through the Texas Baptist World Hunger Offering: 100% goes to support hunger relief & development ministries in Texas and around the world
- **SBTC:** Does not collect monies specifically for hunger or poverty ministry

# So do the two conventions have anything in common?

- **Both** support the *Baptist Faith* & *Message* statement about the Bible.
- **Both** support the missions and causes of the Southern Baptist Convention.
- Both uphold, promote, and teach that the biblical view is that marriage is to be between one man and one woman.
- Both have expressed that the biblical view is that homosexual practices are sinful.
